- 2. 'It seems unlikely that the SDG's can be reached unless issues of security and conflicts are brought into the diagnosis of the obstacles hindering their attainment.' Brozka and Cross (2005). Discuss the extent to which conflict and violence can affect peace and development giving reference to practical examples. (50%)
- 3. Critically examine the role of women in peacebuilding and peacekeeping processes. To what extent has international legislation responded to the historical exclusion of women in decision making processes in peace, conflict and development issues? Refer to specific examples in your discussion. (50%)
