- 3) Emmerson, Robert, Joyce and Grace have been contracted by the Department of Culture and Social Cohesion under the Ministry of Foreign and Interior Affairs to carry out a study on machete wars and human rights in Zimbabwe. Statistics from the Ministry of Gender (2019) show that 1700 cases of machete violence and subsequent tribal conflicts were reported in Zimbabwe and 50% of the reports were from Shurugwi and Mazowe Districts. In addition, the Gender Commission as well as the National Peace and Reconciliation Commission and the Zimbabwe Human Rights Commission also reported that they have received more than 20 complaints related to machete wars in small scale mining areas from Filabusi District. These machete conflicts allegations stirred a lot of violence and displacements in mining communities and has attracted national attention. There is need to find out more through research about machete wars and its implications on national development, social cohesion and nationbuilding. There is a need to establish a programme to promote awareness on the negative impact of violence related to machete wars and build social cohesion. The Government of Zimbabwe is also joining hands with like mind humanitarian organizations to outlaw machete wars and special courts have been established to deal with them already.

From the above background, attempt the following questions:

- i. Identify a suitable theoretical framework for this particular study and justify its relevance (5 marks)
- ii. Explain a suitable research design for the study and justify(5 marks)
- iii. Who are the major stakeholders the research team would consider appropriate for the study and why?(5 marks)
- iv. What sampling methods will the consultants use and why?(5 marks)
- v. Discuss the relevant data analysis procedures they will consider based on theory and research design above (5 marks)
- vi. What are the potential ethical concerns that the consultants need to pay attention to?(5 marks)
