Give a critique of the Basel Convention paying particular attention to why the Convention failed in its attempts to regulate satisfactorily international trade in hazardous waste.

Question Four

'It is mow well accepted that the Bamako Convention goes much further than similar initiatives such as the Basel Convention to address the issue of exportation of hazardous waste into Africa.' Discuss this statement in relation to weaknesses and strengths of the Bamako Convention.

Ouestion Five

Discuss the requirements for adequate hazardous waste management noting the obstacles in relation to establishing adequate hazardous waste management systems and the possible solutions to these obstacles.

Question Six

Give an explanation of and the need for the following on-site hazardous waste management activities:

- a) Separation
- b) Internal hazardous waste collection and temporary storage

Discuss the advantages and disadvantages of incineration as a method of disposing hazardous waste.
