  - b) Evaluate the role of African Indigenous Religion in the practice of democracy in Africa.

  - c) Using your answer in a) and b) above assess to what extent the view that the role of religion in enhancing democracy is relative. [40 Marks]
- 2. Religion contributes to democratic social transformation through the provision of concepts like justice, peace, reconciliation and unity among members of the community.
  - a) Citing examples from your country, explain why democracy is important for governing a nation. [30 Marks]
  - b) Evaluate the role of African Traditional Justice in conflict resolution in an African community of your choice. [30 Marks]
  - c) With reference to any two religions in your country, discuss the role of religion in the democratic transformation of your country. [40 Marks]
