- 2. The nature and purpose of the death of Jesus on the cross continues to be a source of theological debate.
  - a) Explain why it is important to understand that salvation has been made possible because of the atonement of Jesus' death. [30 marks]
  - b) In the light of what you have learnt about Christian teaching on atonement, give a detailed and critical teaching you would deliver to a Sunday school class of young adults on the topic: 'How Jesus' death restored the relationship between God and humanity.'

Erickson defines theology as "a discipline which strives to give a coherent statement of the doctrine of Christian faith, based majorly on the scriptures, place in the context, worded in the contemporary idioms and related to issues of life". With the aid of examples, prepare a Christian education lesson on why it is necessary for a pastor to teach coherently using:

a) The scriptures [20 marks]
b) The biblical context [20 marks]
c) The culture of the audience [30 marks]
d) The contemporary issues of everyday life [30 marks]
