- 1. Assuming as a pastor you have been tasked to teach members to discuss the theological dimensions of sacraments to the Christian community.
  - a) Describe how you would explain the theological message of sacraments to the community of believers; [30 marks]
  - b) Describe how you would explain the relationship between the theology of baptism and the celebration of this sacrament; [30 marks]
  - c) Give a detailed lesson plan of how you would train church members to dialogue with other believers regarding your denomination's understanding of the celebration of the sacrament of baptism.

- 2. Assuming a lay leader of your local church, you invite a Hindu friend to a Sunday service, while in the service the Hindu faithful asks you for an explanation on the challenges and essence of music, dance and rhythm in Christian worship.
  - a) In your response to the Hindu faithful show why it may be important to use biblical theological teachings as a Christian artist; [30 marks]
  - b) In your response to the Hindu faithful, explain the meaning and necessity of music in Christian worship; [30 marks]
  - c) In your response to the Hindu faithful, discuss what you may give as your understanding of the use of dance as part of Christian worship and not secular entertainment. [40 marks]
- 3. Assume that you were part of a group of United Methodist pastors attending a conference on the role of culture in Christian worship in Africa today and you were presenting a paper at that conference.
  - a) Give a critical summary of the notes you would jot down to show your understanding of the terms 'Christian worship' and 'culture'; [30 marks]
  - b) Give a critical summary of what would be your findings on the relationship between culture and Christian worship; [30 marks]
  - c) From your answers in a) and b) above, how would your paper discuss the necessity of practising Christian worship within the cultural context of the worshippers in Africa?
