Section B. Creative Skills and Performance

- 3. Construct a short 20 minute One Act script and briefly explain how you would use it to direct a performance intended to entertain and advise a specific audience about the dangers of drug addiction.
- Write a Two Act 25 minute play involving a couple locked up in a dispute over an alleged extramarital affair with an important government official.

Section C. Adaptation, Improvisation from set texts

- 5. Discuss how you would adapt the play 'The World on A Hill' to highlight the conflict between the rich and the poor as revealed through the woman and the boy actors.
- 6. Choose any story from the collection 'Contemporary African Short Stories' and construct a 20 minute One Act play for performance to a named audience.
