Question One

Design a presentation capturing the nature of various interactions, priorities and strategies that could be used or copied especially around the following interactions:

- a) The Asian Tigers
- b) FOCAC and BIR
- c) TICAD
- d) Languages and Culture
- e) The digital aspects

Question Two

You are engaged as a Research Consultant by the African Development Bank (AfDB) on how the bank can best deal with the effects of Trumps foreign policy and the trade war with China. The terms of reference in the consultancy include:

- To describe for AfDB the salient characteristics of Trumps foreign policy and the trade war with China especially in relation to Africa;
- To identify for AfDB the effects on Africa of Trumps foreign policy and trade war:
- To make recommendations to the AfDB on strategies that can be used to respond to the effects Trumps foreign policy and trade war;
- To make recommendations to the AfDB on how best Africa can best understand and approach the Biden administration's policy to Asia, with particular reference to China.

Write an advisory opinion for the organization addressing the needs identified in its terms of reference. [100 marks]

Question Three

Read the short description below of a diplomatic online shopping success and answer the subsequent question:

James Kimonyo, the Rwandan ambassador to China, stepped into a social media livestream studio for online shopping in Beijing at the height of the COVID-19 crisis in June 2020. He sold 1.5 tons of Rwandan coffee beans in a single second, a record that would normally take a year to breach in China. Kimonyo was an instant Rwandan sensation who had discovered a new-found market on the global digital frontier. Other

African ambassadors in China subsequently joined the many competing livestream shopping channels on the back of Rwanda's success

China has aggressively entered the digital world with start-ups such as Tiktok and Alibaba giving alternative platforms for social media, business marketing, online shopping, and security.

Advise African countries on this new frontier in technology- identifying the historical overtones, telecoms infrastructure and e-commerce opportunities and risks. [100 marks]
