Question 3(20 marks)

- (a) A company is earning a sum of \$50,000 and the rate of return expected is 10%. This company will be said to be properly capitalized. Suppose the capital investment of the company is \$60,000, it will be over capitalization to the extent of \$100 000.

Required:

What is the new rate of earning? **(8 marks)**

- (b) Discuss the effects of overcapitalization of a firm and the remedies thereof. **(12 marks)**

Question 4(20 marks)

- (a) Critically examine the advantages and disadvantages of equity shares. **(12 marks)**
- (b) Discuss the features of equity shares. **(8 marks)**

Question 5(20 marks)

- (a) Critically explain the factors affecting the requirement of working capital. **(5 marks)**
