How far did the dictatorial colonial economy help in the modernization of the economy in African countries before independence?

Question 3

Coups and military takeovers of civilian governments in post-colonial Africa were a result of civilian government's failure to deliver on their promises. Discuss the above assertion.

Question 4

African countries gained their independence through the process of *negotiation*, *armed struggle* and lastly, *negotiation and constitution making*. Assess the three methods; and giving reasons, suggest which of these produced the best expectations for Africans.

Question 5

The role of strong leadership is credited for the achievement of independence by many African countries. Do you agree? Choose **ONE** country you have studied to support your answer.

Question 6

Examine the economic problems which African countries inherited on achievement of independence. How successful have the African governments dealt with the economic problems?
