Using a practical example, distinguish between IT Governance and IT Management, and explain how a failure in governance can lead to inefficiencies in management. [20 marks]

A large financial institution has a mature Information Technology Infrastructure Library (ITIL)-based service management process but has experienced several major project failures due to unclear business objectives. Using governance concepts, diagnose the likely root cause of this problem. [20 marks]

Question 4

Analyse the risks an organization faces when it proceeds with a custom software development project without a formally defined and signed-off Requirements Specification document.

Question 5

Outline a set of controls an auditor would expect to see governing the data migration process to ensure completeness, accuracy, and integrity of the data being moved to the new system.

Critically analyse the statement: "*A strong firewall is the most important control for protecting information assets.*" Discuss the limitations of this view and argue for a more holistic, defence-in-depth approach to security.

Compare and contrast the roles of Preventive, Detective, and Corrective controls in the context of access management. Provide a specific example of each and explain why an auditor would test for the presence of all three types.
