**Question 3**

- a) Describe four positive signs of schizophrenia and key drug management. (10marks)

- c) Explain four adverse effects of antipsychotic drugs. (5marks)

**Question 4**

- a) Examine four aetiological factors of Obsessive Compulsive Disorder (OCD). (10marks)

- c) Analyse three (3) complications of OCD. (6marks)
