Question 1

Robust coercive apparatuses have long been credited with maintaining the Middle East's authoritarian regimes, and the 2011 'Arab Spring' uprisings confirmed their centrality. In Tunisia and Egypt, the military abstained from using force against protesters, while in Syria and Bahrain, militaries defended leaders against mass mobilization with brutal force. In Yemen and Libya, militaries fractured, with some portions remaining loyal to the leader while others defected.

How does the comparative politics literature on the role of the military in domestic politics, and more specifically on the relationship between the role of the military and the success of revolutions, help to explain these divergent outcomes?
