- 1. During the pre-critical period of the Bible, Old Testament scholars have given several views on the authority of the Bible, which determined interpretation, particularly of the Old Testament.
 - a) Give a critical summary of the main arguments given in support of the holiness/sacredness of the Bible (Old Testament) and the special place the Bible occupied during the pre-critical period in the study of the Bible. [40]
 - b) Analyze the contribution of any three pre- scientific factors to the rise of the scientific criticism of the Old Testament. [60]
- 2. Any valid approach to biblical interpretation must seek to bridge the gap between the ancient worlds of the authors of the biblical text and the world of the reader of the biblical text today.
 - a) Examine how any two of the following gaps between the world of the author and the interpreter of the Old Testament act as barriers to accessing the message of the Old Testament.
 - i. Distance of time (time gap)
 - ii. Geographical Distance (spatial gap)
 - iii. Cultural Distance (cultural gap)
 - iv. Distance of Language (language gap) [50]
 - b) 'Christians today are unnecessarily divided among themselves because they do not have a uniform view of the inspiration or authority of the Bible and subsequently, uniform approach to biblical interpretation.' Assess the validity of this statement.
