 - a) Demonstrate your understanding of the concept of 'Hellenization' during the Inter-Testament period. [40]
 - b) Assess the validity of the claim that 'The conquests of Alexander the Great resulted in the spread of Hellenization' in the Greco-Macedonian region, including Palestine, during the Inter-Testament period. [60]
- 3. Stoicism and Epicureanism were some of the Greek philosophical movements during the Inter-Testament period.
 - a) Give a critical summary of the historical origins, beliefs or teachings and practices of **EITHER** Stoicism **OR** Epicureanism. [40]
 - b) As a budding New Testament scholar, examine some of the influences in terms of beliefs or teachings and practices both philosophical movements, Stoicism and Epicureanism, may have had on Christianity today. [60]
