  - a) Using the crisis intervention strategies you learned in class, demonstrate how your church has responded to a crisis that has led to a turning point as far as the wellbeing of the people is concerned, including factors that may have influenced the success of the crisis management process.

  - b) Design a crisis intervention plan (turning point) on how the church can assist in addressing child marriages in a community of your choice. [50]
- 2. There are currently several approaches that are used to provide the theoretical and empirical foundations for crisis intervention. In consideration of this:
  - a) Giving examples, demonstrate how, as a pastoral caregiver, you would make use of relevant tools from the Social Sciences to help people in crisis to address any two common crises in your community.
