1. CASE STUDY ONE

2. CASE STUDY TWO

Assume that the secretary of the Ministry of Health in your country has selected you to lead a group of researchers to investigate the low uptake of the COVID -19 vaccine in a community that you know very well in your country. The secretary is speculating that religious beliefs are contributing to the negative attitude that members of this community have towards the vaccine. The population is diverse in terms of age, gender and level of education.

- a) Formulate an appropriate topic, research problem, three research objectives and research questions for this study. [40]
- b) Articulate with justification, appropriate research design, sampling methods, the methods that you will use to collect data and analyze data from participants involved in this study.
